***All fees are quoted in Australian Dollars, are current at the time of printing and may be subject to change (please see our website for current fees). If the fees are increased, families will be required to pay the new fees as they are updated. Any difference between the fees quoted in the Written Agreement and the subsequent fees for the following year will be added to the first fee statement of that year.**

Tuition and non-tuition fees for the school year are charged in two (2) instalments in January and July and are payable within 14 days of billing.

GST: Most of the College's fees and charges are not subject to the Goods and Services Tax [GST]. Any GST included in charges is specifically identified on the account when rendered.

Application Fee

An application fee is required upon submission of a formal Application for Enrolment to the College. This fee is non-refundable and covers the administration costs associated with the initial prospective application including the student interview.

Enrolment Confirmation Fee

A place is confirmed for a child only after an offer has been made and the Enrolment Confirmation Fee is paid. Should the enrolment not proceed, the Enrolment Confirmation Fee is non-refundable. In the event of visa refusal, the confirmation fee will be considered in any refund owed, as per the school's international student refund policy

Notes

1. *It is College policy that fees are paid in advance as outlined by the National ESOS Authority.*
2. *Student visa holders must have health cover for the duration of their study in Australia.*
3. **Boarding payment covers term time (37 weeks).** Boarders are expected to go home during vacation periods. *If a student remains at JPC during school holidays, a homestay will be provided if available, and the associated homestay for borders during holiday fees will be incurred.*
4. **Homestay payment covers 46 weeks per year.** *The homestay program will be closed during the Christmas holiday, and students are expected to return home for the summer holiday in December - January. Homestay payment must be received before the first day of each term. A late fee of \$50 per week is charged on any balances owing after the first week of term.*
5. *Applicable to students in College Homestay and Boarding*

General Conditions

- Tuition fees are effective for the current calendar year and will remain until they are changed by the Board of Directors.
- While the Board of Directors aims to set fees on an annual basis, it reserves the right to change these at any time.
- As specified in the agreement signed with the College, fees are payable in advance, as per invoice.

Change of Visa Status [ie. student becomes a temporary or permanent resident]

When an Overseas Visa student has a change of visa status, he / she will continue to pay full overseas student fees for the duration of that term. Evidence of the new visa status will be required.



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
